Compiled initially by Leonard Manns and published in the 2000 SxBR; updated in 2013 and 2020.

## Notes:

1. A Sussex Bird Report was produced by G des Forges *et al* for the years 1948 to 1961, but consisted primarily of a systematic list with additional brief notes.
2. The Sussex Ornithological Society was formed in 1962 and reports for that year onward have been produced by the Society. It is from these reports that the following list has been compiled.
